## "Let My Mother's spirit live in you"

Dear Sisters and Associates,

When heart speaks to heart, one opens oneself to be transformed by the tender caress of love. Over the past year, our hearts have been attuned to the heart of Jesus.

In the short Note 33, in Obedience Notes Volume 4, Venerable Mary Potter shares some of her heart to heart conversation with Jesus. She invites us to hear the words of Jesus which encouraged her and shaped the spirit of our Little Company of Mary:

## "Let My Mother's spirit live in you."

That same invitation is offered to each one of us.

As Pope Francis says,

When faith makes a place for the Mother of God, we never lose sight of the centre: the Lord, for Mary never points to herself but to Jesus and our brothers and sisters, for Mary is mother ... Mother of God, teach us to see life as you do.

Surely, we are invited to walk with the Mary of the Visitation, to carry Christ to the lonely, unsure, sick and in need, dying, be it in body, spirit or soul; to greet the Christ within each person with that same love and tenderness of the Mother who was willing to do all she could to meet the needs of another.

Is not our call to hold prayerfully, with Mary of the Presentation, the reality of life? It is in lives shaped to the heart of the Mother of Jesus that we truly find our unity, can depth the reality of our one heart and the possibilities inherent in our spirit, for love of the God of Love.

In Jesus words to Ven. Mary Potter, we hear a whisper to our own hearts. If we choose to let the spirit of the Mother of God shape and reshape us, and act from that same spirit of tenderness and compassion, then we too, like Ven. Mary Potter, will give joy to the Mother of God, which as Jesus

says: "is the joy of my heart". Let us now invite Mary, Mother of the God of Love, into our hearts anew and ponder with her, what it is to bear that Love to those we meet.

As our Holy Father reminds us,
